

Barrus expands engine line-up

Barrus will be showing the latest petrol and diesel engines from the well-known brands of Yanmar, John Deere and Kohler.

New to the Yanmar line-up is the 2V750, the world's first liquid cooled, V-twin diesel engine. With a new design cast iron cylinder head and improved vibration characteristics, the new engine is emission compliant to EPA Tier II. This engine will be suitable for a number of applications

including lawn and garden machinery, vertical generators, hydraulic power packs and other general industrial uses.

Kohler has also expanded the horsepower offering in the Command Pro Line. The new 30hp twin-cylinder Command PRO vertical (CV750) and horizontal-shaft (CH750) models are designed for larger commercial mowers and zero turn radius equipment, welding, construction and concrete

equipment. The 747cc, air-cooled, overhead valve engine also features a two-barrel carburettor that delivers enhanced performance in the equipment powered by this engine. A new high flow fan provides improved thermal management to keep oil temperatures cool during the entire power range, regardless of application or duty cycle.
